ORDER GRANTING STAY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 6, 2002, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") filed a Motion for Reconsideration and Petition for a Stay of the Commission's October 18, 2002 Enforcement Order in this cause. ITC DeltaCom Communications, Inc. ("ITC DeltaCom") filed a Response to BellSouth's Motion for Reconsideration on November 22, 2002. ITC DeltaCom opposes BellSouth's Motion for Reconsideration and BellSouth's Request for a Stay of the Commission's October 18, 2002 Enforcement Order.

Having considered the arguments raised in the aforementioned pleadings, the Commission finds that the public interest will best be served by a grant of BellSouth's Petition for a Stay. The Commission's October 18, 2002 Enforcement Order in this cause is hereby stayed while BellSouth's Motion for Reconsideration is assessed further.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That BellSouth's Petition for a Stay of the Commission's October 18, 2002 Enforcement Order in this cause is hereby granted until further notice by the Commission.
